2010 Pavement Management Project, River Acres District H

July 12, 2010

Residents

The pavement management project has been awarded and construction has begun. This notice is to keep you informed of the contractor's construction schedule. On Wednesday, expect to see some preparatory work beginning on your streets. If you have children take proper precautions.

Many residents have notified the City and SEH about concerns and conflicts that may arise during the construction project. If you have any concerns, questions or comments about the construction project, please leave a message at one of the contact numbers below. i.e if you have underground irrigation near the roadway, you should let us know.

Tuesday July 13, 2010 Xcel Energy will begin locating gas services under the roadway. You may see small areas of turf disturbed along the roadway. On Wednesday, July 14, 2010 and Thursday July 15, 2010 the contractor will begin reclaiming the paved roadway. The streets which will be reclaimed are 110th Street S., and 113th Street S. The paved roadway will transform into a gravel road. There will be heavy equipment performing work throughout this project. Starting Wednesday **No Parking** will be allowed on roadways between 7AM and 7PM. Access to your driveways will be maintained. Tree trimming has been started on Inman Ave S and will continue throughout this week. Any trees which overhang the roadway and cause an obstruction for emergency vehicles will be trimmed on all streets. Additional trees will be removed along Inman Ave S, 110th Street S, and River Acres Road at the proposed bus turnaround location.

During the milling/reclaiming process, a two to three foot area beyond the pavement edge will be disturbed by the large milling machine. Please pull back or remove any invisible dog fence, any flowers, or decorative items within the two to three foot area should be removed to avoid any damage.

MAIL & GARBAGE SERVICE During the project mail will be delivered as normal to your mail boxes. It is not anticipated that any mail boxes will need to be relocated at this time. Garbage Service will also be provided as usual.

The estimated time for the entire construction project is two months (weather permitting).
